If you have other family members on the <u>plan</u> , each family member must meet their own individual <u>deductible</u> until the total amount of <u>deductible</u> expenses paid by all family members meets the overall family <u>deductible</u> .
Are there services covered before you meet your deductible?	Yes. The following participating <u>provider</u> services: <u>primary care</u> <u>physician's</u> office visits, <u>urgent care physician, preventive care,</u> and <u>prescription drugs</u> are covered before you meet your <u>deductible</u> . Does this plan provide Minimum Essential Coverage? Yes
